


Who is eligible for services?

- Michigan residents
- Adults and children diagnosed with a blood cancer or precancerous blood condition
- Parents, spouses, siblings and caregivers of blood cancer patients
- No age limits
- No income requirements

BCFM covers nearly 200 types of blood cancers and blood disorders, including:

- Leukemia
- Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma
- · Hodgkin's disease
- Multiple myeloma
- · Aplastic anemia
- · Fanconi's anemia
- Myelodysplastic syndromes
- Myeloproliferative disorders
- Other malignant or potentially malignant disorders of the blood, lymphatic system or bone marrow

More benefits of enrolling with BCFM

- **Lifelong support.** Recognizing the uniqueness and unpredictability of blood cancer, BCFM never discharges patients from services. Patients and families may continue to receive emotional support and attend outings as long as they would like, and patients are eligible for financial assistance up to 10 years into remission.
- Comprehensive support. BCFM is the only organization in Michigan to offer all of these services to blood cancer patients in one place, freeing up patients' time and allowing them to focus on their own well-being.
- Prevent barriers that may arise. Enrolling early/upon diagnosis helps patients and families alleviate the need to scramble for assistance when an urgent situation occurs.
